English Language Arts - April 18 and 19 Math - April 30 and May 1


Fourth Grade

Ohio's State Tests

It's that time of year! Spring has begun and state testing is quickly approaching. The Ohio's State Tests (OSTs) for the Middle School and High School are scheduled to begin at the end of April and continue into the beginning of May. During this time our students will take state assessments for Language Arts, Math, Algebra, Geometry, American History, Government and Biology. If you have any questions concerning these tests please do not hesitate to contact Mr. Root or Mrs. Peck.

Test results from the OSTs provide the primary means for Ohio to rate Holgate Middle School/High School in the areas of Achievement and Progress.

Achievement - measures student academic achievement using each level of performance on the Ohio's State Tests.

Progress - measures the academic performance of students compared to expected growth in Ohio's State Tests.

In 2023, Holgate Middle School/High School achieved a commendable 4 of 5 stars in Achievement and demonstrated notable progress with 3 of 5 stars in Progress. Our dedicated teachers have utilized the data from these assessments to tailor their approach to each student's needs. Moving forward, we are committed to further advancements in both categories. aspiring to attain ratings that reflect our ongoing dedication and excellence.


